A Legacy of Faith and Family Apostle Portia Minter is a woman of God whose life is firmly rooted in a rich spiritual heritage. The daughter of the late John S. and Madie H. Tigner, and granddaughter of the late Rev. C. H. Tigner and Rev. C. R. Harris, she carries a multi-generational mantle of ministry. Alongside her husband, Deacon Terrell Minter, she has built a beautiful family, including her children—Alunda, Robert, and Jonathan—and her beloved grandchildren, Emery and Armoni.

The Call to Ministry and Pastoral Leadership Apostle Minter accepted her divine calling in May 1987 and was ordained into the Gospel Ministry on May 22, 1990, at The True Light Baptist Church under the late Rev. C. I. Fowler, Jr. After ten years of faithful service, she transitioned into pastoral leadership following a clear mandate from the Lord in 1998. This led to the birth of **The Christian Jubilee Full Word Baptist Church, Inc.**, a ministry dedicated to “Preparing a People Who Will be Able to Celebrate the Return of Our Lord Jesus Christ.” In 2025, her years of steadfast service culminated in her elevation to the sacred Office of Apostleship.

A Scholar and Lifelong Learner With a commitment to excellence, Apostle Minter has pursued rigorous theological and clinical training. Her academic achievements include:

- **B.A. in Biblical Studies** (Honors) from Beulah Heights Bible College (1996).
- **M.A. in Leadership Studies** from Beulah Heights University (2014).
- **Licensed Clinical Pastoral Counselor** specializing in Temperament and Family Therapy (2001).
- **Honors:** Multiple inductions into the *Who’s Who Among Students* and the Beta Eta Beta Kappa and Delta Epsilon Chi Honor Societies.

Healing and Reconciliation In 1994, Apostle Minter founded the **Christian Women’s Ministerial Association of Georgia (C.W.M.A.)**, a counseling ministry designed to offer healing and reconciliation to women in the Five-Fold Ministry who have been spiritually wounded. This heart for restoration extends to her work with marriages; she is a passionate advocate for traditional Christian unions and hosts an annual “Marriage Tune-up Clinic” to strengthen families and mentor the youth.

Community Impact and Authorship After retiring from the State of Georgia with 30 years of service, Apostle Minter dedicated herself even more deeply to community transformation. She is an active voice in the **One Race Movement for Racial Reconciliation** and advocates for critical issues such as health awareness and the abolition of human sex trafficking. In 2019, she expanded her reach as an author, founding **Stay True to the Word Ministries, LLC**, and publishing her first book, *"25 Life-Changing Reasons for Church Attendance,"* in 2022.
